Working in a team centered environment, and reporting to the Executive Director, the Health Safety & Wellness Advisor will work with a Steering Committee to develop mental health strategies in accordance Anishinaabe Culture and practices for Nokiiwin member First Nation communities.

The Health Safety & Wellness Advisor's primary function is to facilitate services that help member First Nation workplaces improve mental health and wellbeing through the continued development and application of the G'minoomaadozimin Project. To achieve this important goal, the Advisor must also consult on priorities, develop workplans and budgets, seek innovative solutions, pursue additional resources, measure success, build a central source of information, maintain professional networks, and advocate on behalf of communities.
