

Leadership Series – Call for Artwork

Nokiiwin Tribal Council is calling on artists to submit a piece of artwork for the Leadership Series handbook. All submissions should be done through email and sent to <u>capacitycoordinator@nokiiwin.com</u>. Upon submission, the artist will receive a confirmation within 1-2 business days stating that we have received the submission and we will be reviewing it, along with other submissions.

All submissions – physical and digital – are to be indigenous-centric and should include a short artist statement (100-150 words). This statement should include the description and meaning of the piece of work, the creative process and any other information regarding the artists specialization, current position, community or other featured works or exhibitions if applicable.

Physical Art Submissions

If you wish to submit a physical piece of artwork (drawing, painting, etc.) please include the size of the piece as well as a clear photograph of the piece. Please be sure that the photo allows for full viewing of the artwork with the ability to see details in your work. Multiple pictures can be sent as an attachment with your initial piece submission via email.

Digital Art Submissions

If you wish to submit digital art, the submission should include the following:

- ✓ The original, editable file (AI, PSD, ESP files)
- ✓ A vector ESP file for digital (RGB)
- ✓ A vector ESP file for print (CMYK)
- ✓ A web preview file (PNG, JPEG, PDF)
- ✓ If the design is a full-bleed print design, bleed areas must be included

Terms of Submission and Participation

All artworks should be in excellent condition and available for shipping. The submission piece cannot be submitted or in submission to any other call or competition for art. The artist understands that by submitting a piece of art to Nokiiwin Tribal Council Call for Art, they are doing so with full intent to transfer all copyrights to Nokiiwin Tribal Council and thereby forego any claims to the piece. All artists must be able to confirm 100% copyright and or permissions regarding the work as well as any imagery used in the work of art that is submitted. *The work is void of any signatures. For a submission to be considered, it might be deemed as being legitimate, and being submitted in good faith.

Disclaimer

*If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified for any reason, Nokiiwin Tribal Council reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion. Nokiiwin also reserves the right to not award the prize if submissions are deemed unsuitable for the project in which they were intended.
