

Ziigwin "Rise Up" Human Trafficking Awareness Program – Call for Artwork

The Access to Justice Department at Nokiiwin Tribal Council is calling on artists to submit a piece of artwork to be used with promotional material in their Ziigwin "Rise Up" Human Trafficking Awareness program. We are looking for four pieces of artwork, artists may submit more than one piece of artwork for consideration.

All submissions should be done through email with one piece of artwork per submission and sent to <u>socialworker@nokiiwin.com</u>. Upon submission, the artist will receive a confirmation email within 1-2 business days stating that the submission was received and is being reviewed, along with other submissions.

*The invitation is open to all of First Nations ancestry and must be 18 years of age or older.

All submissions are to be original, indigenous-centric digital artwork and incorporate one of the following themes:

- Human Trafficking (Men, Women, and Children)
- Recovery and Healing
- Empowerment of Self or Others
- Growth and Progress
- Justice or Accessing Justice
- Strength in Community

Prize

Each selected winner will receive a prize of one-thousand dollars (\$1000).

Digital Art Submission Guidelines

- The original, editable file (AI, PSD, EPS files)
- A vector EPS file for digital (RGB)
- A vector EPS file for print (CMYK)
- A web preview file (PNG, JPEG, PDF)
- If the design is a full-bleed print design, bleed areas must be included

Submissions should also include a short artist statement (100-150-word). This statement should include the overall theme, creative process, and any information regarding artists' specialization, medium, current position, community, or other featured works or exhibitions, if applicable.

Terms of Submission and Participation

The invitation is open to all of First Nations ancestry and must be 18 years of ae or older. The submission piece cannot be submitted or in submission to any other call or competition for art. The artist understands that by submitting a piece of art to Nokiiwin Tribal Council Call for Art, they are doing so with full intent to transfer all copyrights to Nokiiwin Tribal Council and thereby forego any claims to the piece. All artists must be able to confirm 100% copyright and or permissions regarding the work as well as any imagery used in the work of art that is submitted. *The work is to be void of any signatures. For a submission to be considered, it must be deemed as being legitimate, and being submitted in good faith.

Disclaimer

*If a winner cannot be contacted or is disqualified for any reason, Nokiiwin Tribal Council reserves the right to determine an alternate winner or not to award that winner's prize, in its sole discretion. Nokiiwin also reserves the right to not award the prize if submissions are deemed unsuitable for the project in which they were intended.

Submission Deadline: March 7, 2023 Winners will be announced the week of March 13th – 17^{th.}
